Training Underway for Local Election Officials in New Hampshire

CONCORD, NH (August 17, 2022): In preparation of the September 13 New Hampshire State Primary, the Secretary of State's Office will host training sessions for local election officials throughout August. These sessions, open to Moderators, Clerks, Selectmen, Supervisors of the Checklist and Inspectors of Election (Ballot Clerks), provide a detailed overview of election law and a step-by-step breakdown of the processes carried out by election officials before, during, and after state elections. The sessions are open to election officials only and will take place in Atkinson, Campton, Colebrook, Conway, Gorham, Haverhill, Keene, Manchester, Newport, Portsmouth, Rindge, and Wolfeboro.

On-demand training webinars will also be made available by the Secretary of State's Office for election officials who are not able to make the in-person trainings or who would like to refresh their knowledge closer to the election.

New Hampshire elections are well-run and transparent because they are conducted by locally elected election officials and poll worker volunteers. Through this training, election officials will be further equipped with the tools, resources and knowledge they need to make 2022 another successful election year.
