

Written Appeal to the Ballot Law Commission from a Recount  
Pursuant to NH RSA 665:8

1. Printed Name of Candidate Filing Appeal: Maxine Mosley
2. County and Number of State Representative District: Hillsborough 16
3. Date of Declaration by Secretary of State that said Candidate did not have the greatest number of votes: November 22, 2022
4. Date this Written Appeal is Filed with the Secretary of State: November 23, 2022

The Candidate identified above (hereafter, the Appellant) hereby appeals to the Ballot Law Commission the declaration of the Secretary of State following a recount that the Candidate did not have the greatest number of votes received in the November 8, 2022 election in the above-referenced State Representative District and further states the following:

1. This written appeal was filed with the Secretary of State within three days after said declaration.
2. That by reason of the inaccurate determination by the Secretary of State of votes for or against or both the Appellant, the Appellant has a greater number of votes than the candidate determined by the Secretary of State to have the greatest number of votes sufficient to have been elected.
3. That the Ballot Law Commission, upon its review and consideration of the rulings of the Secretary of State and its determination of the ballots covered by those rules, should,
  - (i) change the declaration of the Secretary of State,
  - (ii) issue a certification of such changed declaration to the Appellant, and
  - (iii) declare in such changed declaration and certification that the Appellant received the number of votes sufficient to have been elected on November 8, 2022 to the above-referenced State Representative District.
